Additional materials will be e-mailed and provided at the MANDATORY Student & Parent Orientation Meeting on Wednesday, April 26, at 7 pm, at Painesville Township Park Community Center, 1025 Hardy Rd., Painesville Twp. After attending the Ohio Boating License Course Sessions I and II, there is a test that must be passed with a score higher than 70% in order to move forward to the on-the-water portion of the program. Students will attend three days on or near the water at Fairport Harbor Lakefront Park. The on-the-water schedule will require that students attend classes for one week (see attached schedule).

If chosen, students will participate in on-the-water instruction on the following types of watercraft:

kayaks • stand-up paddleboards Jon (motor) boats with 9.9 hp motors canoes • PWC (jet skis) United States Coast Guard watercraft • JY 14 sail boats
