After completing the second session of the Ohio Boating License Course, there is a test that must be passed with a score higher than 70% in order to move forward to the on-the-water portion of the program. The on-the-water schedule will require that students attend classes for one week.

If chosen, students will participate in on-the-water instruction on the following types of watercraft:

> kayaks • stand-up paddleboards Jon (motor) boats with 9.9 hp motors canoes • PWC (jet skis)

United States Coast Guard watercraft • JY 14 sail boats
