3. Due to the scheduled closure rules for the buildings and for the safety of both your child(ren) and the camp counselor a Ranger will be called for assistance after 6 pm.

4. Doors do not open for morning extended hours until 7:30 am. No exceptions. Please do not leave your child unattended at any of our facilities.

5. Children will only be released to the person designated on the sign-in sheet with proper identification. Children may not be released to caregivers who have consumed alcohol.

6. Lake Metroparks staff will provide quiet activities for your child(ren) during extended hours. These may include "G" rated videos, board and children's card games and quiet reading time. Extended hours are provided as a public service for our campers, it is not intended to be an extension of our camp program.
