- Ages 10 & older, younger than 18 with an adult
- No riders not paddling in race. Maximum two people per boat.
- · Prior experience is mandatory.
- Parking is available on the north and south sides of Harpersfield Dam.
- Life jackets must be worn at all times or racer will be disqualified. No inflatable life jackets. No Type II life jackets.
- All canoes and kayaks must be properly registered with the state of Ohio as ODNR Parks & Watercraft may inspect boats. For more information, call ODNR Watercraft Office at 216-361-1212.
- In the event of bad weather, high water, etc., Lake Metroparks reserves the right to cancel, postpone or alter the race for the safety of all racers and spectators.
