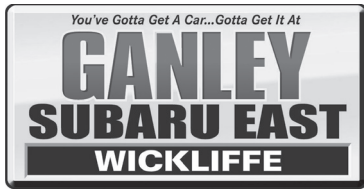

Ice Sculpture Facts

- The ice used to carve a two block ice sculpture has a starting weight of 600 pounds
- A four block ice sculpture has a starting weight of 1,200 pounds
- The battle between fire and ice usually lasts for 30 to 45 minutes
- The ice thrones are made from seven to ten blocks of ice
