SUPPLY LIST

Material fee \$18 (templates and pattern)

Rotary cutter

Medium rotary mat

Quilter's ruler 6"x24 or 6"x12 (your choice, we will be cutting strips with this ruler)

Straight pins with heads

Marking pencil: light and dark

Light Gray thread for sewing machine

Sewing Machine in good working order

Small bottle of Best Press or Magic Sizing

Basic sewing supplies you always like to work with (thread clips, seam ripper, etc.)

Fabric Selection

(Select non-busy fabrics for the best results. Examples would be tone on tone basics or tone on tone batiks. A tone on tone fabric is a fabric without much pattern.)

Light green - $\frac{1}{4}$ yard

Medium green - $\frac{1}{4}$ yard

Dark green - $\frac{1}{4}$ yard

Light blue - $\frac{1}{3}$ yard

Medium blue - $\frac{1}{4}$ yard

Dark blue - $\frac{1}{4}$ yard

Light purple - $\frac{1}{4}$ yard

Medium purple - $\frac{1}{4}$ yard

Dark purple - $\frac{1}{4}$ yard

Light red/orange - $\frac{1}{3}$ yard

Medium red/orange - $\frac{1}{4}$ yard

Dark red/orange - $\frac{1}{4}$ yard

Background and binding - $\frac{3}{4}$ yard (this can be purchased after class.)

Background color: I used black as the background color. However, this can be a neutral color, such as black, white, cream or a neutral color of your choice. We will use this to surround the cubes.
