(3 hours)

Fabrics required (Refer to picture)

White/Background 5 yds.

Fabric A $\frac{3}{4}$ yd. (Dark Blue- same in all blocks)

Fabric B $\frac{1}{8}$ yd. of 5 different fabrics. These complement fabric A. It is important to have contrast between A and B

Other supplies

Sewing machine in good working condition with $\frac{1}{4}$ " presser foot

Mettler OR Aurifil 50 wt- cotton sewing thread, neutral to match your fabrics

80/12 Microtex sharp needles for sewing machine (I like Schmetz)

Rotary cutting mat, rulers and cutter with new blade

Extra fine patchwork pins (Clover art. No. 2507) (I will have some for sale)

Stiletto or curved tweezers (I will have some for sale)

Small sharp scissors

Paper and Pencil

Sewing glasses

Anything else you can't sew without

Student Advanced Preparation

Press all fabrics before cutting

Fabric A cut 5 strips 4" x wof

Fabric B from each of the 5 fabrics cut 1 strip 4" x wof (width of fabric)

From Background Fabric

cut 10 strips 6" x wof

cut 2 strips 5.5" x wof into 6 sections 5.5" x 13.5"
