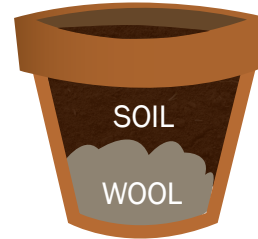

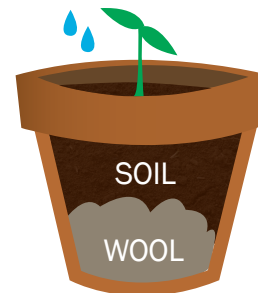
How to use wool in planters



To use wool in **planters or pots**, fill about half full with loosely packed wool. Fill the rest of the planter or pot with potting soil, plant either seeds or plants and water.



To use wool in **outdoor hanging baskets**, line basket with approximately three inches of loosely packed wool. Fill the rest of the hanging basket with potting soil, plant either seeds or plants and water.



Wool in planters helps aerate the roots and also keeps them moist longer.

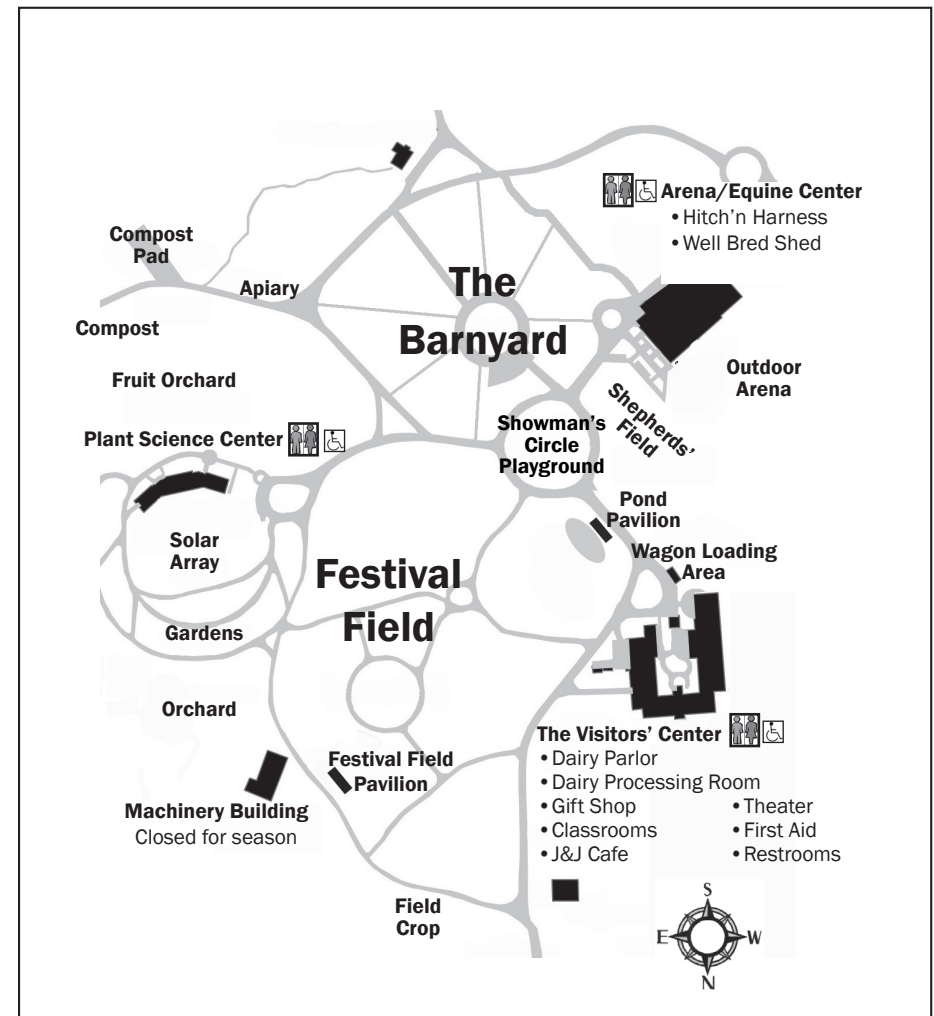

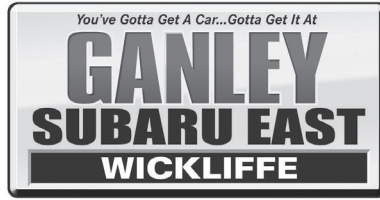
