

## EDUCATION FACILITIES

### FARMPARK

Group size: varies according to program

Named one of “10 Great Places to Dig up Old Dirt on Farming” by *USA Today*, the national award-winning 235-acre Farmpark is a hands-on science and cultural center. Discover how wind and solar power are harvested, explore *The Great Tomato Works*, a hydroponics greenhouse, fields, forests, gardens, orchards, vineyards and meet more than 50 breeds of farm animals.

### CHILDREN’S SCHOOLHOUSE NATURE PARK

Group size: up to 30 students per program

The Children’s Schoolhouse Nature Park features two classrooms, interactive exhibits, a hands-on Discovery Room, a Bug Zoo and a wildlife observation room. A half-mile trail winds through meadow, forest, stream and pond habitats and includes two outdoor teaching areas. The facility and most of the trails are accessible.

### ENVIRONMENTAL LEARNING CENTER

Group size: varies according to program

The Lake Metroparks Environmental Learning Center is a state-of-the-art science and educational facility that connects people with nature through environmental education. It features teaching exhibits, fully equipped classrooms, an astronomical observatory, a biology/biotechnology lab and a weather station.

### PENITENTIARY GLEN NATURE CENTER

Group size: up to 60 students per program

Penitentiary Glen Nature Center features classrooms, an auditorium, hands-on exhibits, a wildlife viewing area and a picnic shelter. Three-and-a-half miles of designated trails lead to field, forest, pond and marsh habitats and to the edge of the famous gorge.

### THE KEVIN P. CLINTON WILDLIFE CENTER AT PENITENTIARY GLEN RESERVATION

Group size: up to 30 students per program, 30 or more students for assembly programs

The Wildlife Center is dedicated to helping injured and orphaned native Ohio wildlife through wildlife rehabilitation and environmental education. Recovering wildlife are housed in enclosures and flight cages in the animal yard prior to release. Local hawks, owls and other permanent residents are also visible in the animal yard. An accessible trail loops through the yard.

### CHAPIN FOREST RESERVATION

Group size: varies according to program

The 390 acres of Chapin Forest Reservation are known for distinctive rock formations and majestic forests. Hike through 5.3 miles of mature woodland trails comprised of beech, maple, oak, tulip and hemlock.

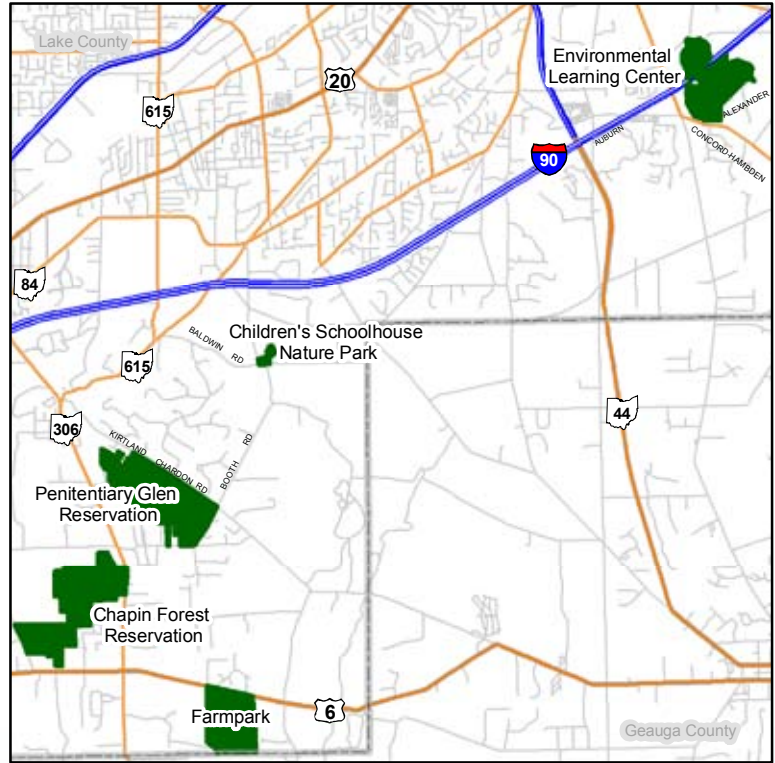
