WE OFFER HANDS-ON LEARNING adventures that focus on farming, nature, wildlife or recreation experiences and incorporate cooperative group learning. Our programs are available year-round for all group sizes from individual classrooms to school assemblies. You can supplement your curriculum with a program in one of the parks.

Scheduling

Please schedule at least **two weeks** in advance. Call between 8:30 a.m. and 4:30 p.m. weekdays. To schedule a program, please call the phone number indicated in the program description.

Be prepared with first and second choices of dates and times and have the "Registration Checklist" information (on back cover) ready when you call. Spring and fall dates fill well in advance!

In order to maximize your visit to Lake Metroparks, please confirm your arrival and departure times with your transportation department several days before your visit.

Fees: programs at our parks

- Program fees are **\$4 per student, \$40 minimum** unless otherwise noted.
- Minimum of ten participants for any program; inquire about maximums or scheduling back-to-back programs when you call.
- One adult admitted free for every ten students in grades 1-12. One adult admitted free for every five preschool and kindergarten students. Additional adults are charged the student program fee. Please mention if you plan to bring a student aide when you register.
- Teachers or group leaders are required to accompany the group.
- Add \$1 per student materials fee for the Linking Up: From Owl Pellets to Food Webs and Advanced Linking Up: From Owl Pellets to Food Webs programs. Add \$2 for Santa's Workshop program.

Fees: programs at your school

- Assembly programs are \$150 for the first presentation and \$100 for each additional presentation the same day at the same location. Assembly programs are for groups of 30 or more students.
- The Renewable Energy outreach program is \$250 for one to four classes per day.
- All other outreach programs are \$4 per student, \$40 minimum unless otherwise noted. Inquire about scheduling back-to-back programs when you call.
- Programs that require the presenter to travel outside Lake County are charged an additional fee.
- Add \$1 per student materials fee for the Linking Up: From Owl Pellets to Food Webs and Advanced Linking Up: From Owl Pellets to Food Webs programs.
