- Teacher guides complement most programs with pre- and post-visit activities, background information and a listing of how the program aligns with the State Academic Content Standards.
- All Lake Metroparks facilities are wheelchair accessible and maintain first-aid stations. Sign interpreters can be scheduled with a minimum two-week advance notice. TTY is available at (440) 358-7275.
- Custom program packages can be created for year-round, multi-visit programs or grant projects. Lake Metroparks staff collaborates with area teachers to develop customized programs that make full use of our facilities' potential to reinforce concepts and skills in science, language arts, history, math, nutrition or art in themed units on farming, nature, recreation, physical education, health or related topics.
