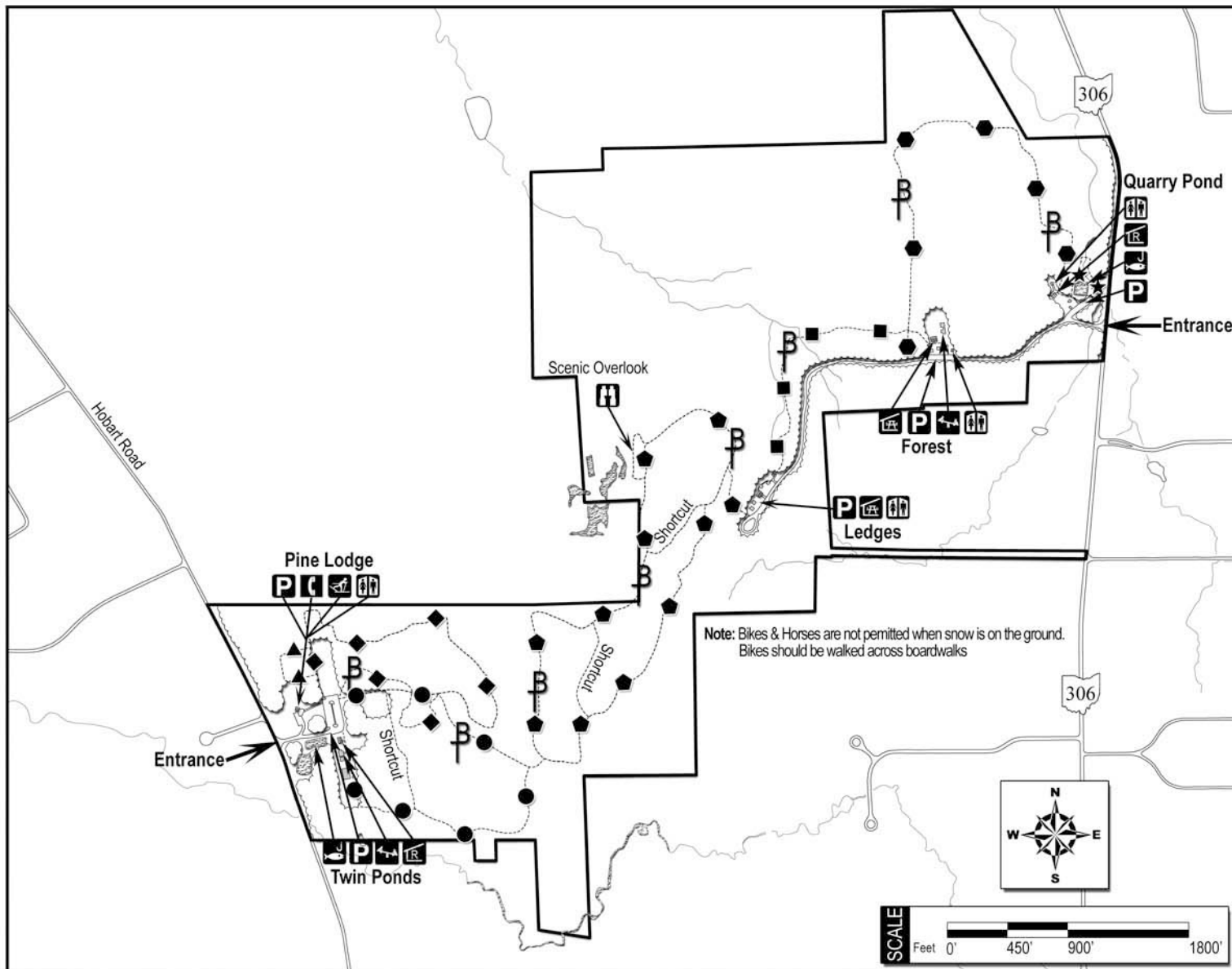
Trail Information

- Ruffed Grouse Trail
1.25 miles, gravel surface
- Lucky Stone Loop
1.5 miles, gravel surface
- Parcourse Loop
1 mile, gravel surface with bridge
- Whispering Pines Trail
25 mile, dirt & grass surface
- Turkey Trail
4 mile, gravel surface
- Quarry Trail
1 mile, gravel surface
- Stonecutters Loop
.12 mile, gravel surface
- Buckeye Trail

Rules to Remember

Hike on designated trails as indicated on this map.
Pets on a leash are welcome in the park; please clean up after them.
Please keep waterfowl and other animals healthy by not feeding them.
Fishing is permitted with a valid Ohio fishing license, catch and release is encouraged.
Park opens at sunrise and closes 1/2 hour after sunset.
The park is home to many plants and animals, do not disturb or move them.
Alcohol is not permitted in the park.
Please keep Lake Metroparks clean, safe and fun for everyone!
