DUTIES AND RESPONSIBILITIES:

1. Habitat and nutritional needs of native Ohio wildlife
2. Training/enrichment of program raptors, mammals, reptiles
3. Animal husbandry and triage
4. Weighing of animals/record keeping
5. Feeding and care of baby mammals, songbirds and waterfowl
6. Release of animals
7. Assist with programs, special events, and fairs

QUALIFICATIONS:

1. Must not have any physical or health conditions that could put you at risk for injuries or zoonotics.
2. 18 year old minimum
3. Must be able to work in a fast-paced environment
4. Must be willing to get dirty and work under any weather conditions.
5. Must be willing to deal with the public in a friendly and professional manner.
6. Tetanus shots are highly recommended.

There will be a minimum of eight hours per month required.

Pick a day of the week and that will be your assigned day.
