

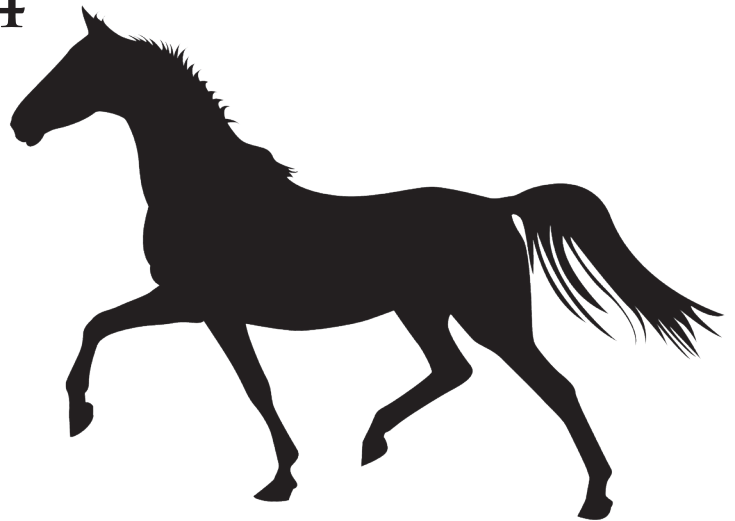

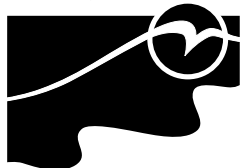
Food is available at J & J Café located in the Farmpark Visitors Center.

PLEASE TAKE NOTE:

1. Walk/trot competitors may not enter Open Division Classes and Open Competitors may not enter W/T.
2. Fee must be paid in full before the class begins.
3. Cancellations must be made before class begins or you will be charged class fee.
4. All horses REQUIRE negative Coggins results within 1 year.
5. All horses that kick require a RED ribbon in their tails.
6. All riders younger than 18 must wear a helmet.
7. All riders 18 and older must wear a helmet or sign a waiver.
8. Managers have final say in all classes; all decisions are final.
9. Unsportsmanlike behavior will not be tolerated. The result is expulsion without refund.
10. Severe bits or equipment prohibited. Managers reserve the right to excuse anyone using inappropriate equipment from class or Farmpark.
11. Any horse being unruly and/or out of control may be asked to leave Farmpark.
12. If equipment or tack should break and the rider is able to complete the run without injury or discomfort to the horse, the run will be considered complete.
13. Loss of forward motion, falling off the horse or not using a proper pattern are all reasons for disqualification of an entry.
14. Riders must have control of their horses going into and coming out of the arena (walking is preferred).
15. All spectators are to enter the Farmpark through the Visitors Center and pay Farmpark admission.
16. Appropriate show attire is appreciated.
