

Economy Star Supply List

The large eight-pointed star we'll be making is a common string pieced block. The star(s) 22" square and I have 2 quilt plans for you to choose between – one is a medallion style with one large star, the other is a 72" square quilt with four of the large stars. The 4-star one is on the teaching schedule page of my website, <http://www.maryhueyquilts.com/id69.html>

- Sewing machine
- Angler II by Pam Bono for accurate ¼" seams, or ¼" presser foot, and regular presser foot.
- Rotary cutting tools including large mat, basic 18 to 24" long ruler, largest square ruler you own, and a rotary cutter
- Marti Michell's Corner Trimmer (\$4) will be available at the workshop that day.
- Medium value, neutral color cotton thread (gray or tan)
- Basic sewing supplies
- You might also want to bring a cushion to sit on.

Fabric Yardages for 1 star approximately 22" square:

- ½ yard cotton fabric for diamond foundations – can be muslin or a light colored fabric you don't want.
- ½ yard for setting squares and triangles in the big block – my sample used white.
- I'll bring my scrap strip bags for you to plunder or you can bring a pile of strips and scraps from your stash – chose all one color family, or go very scrappy, or pick a theme such as patriotic.
- On the second day, we'll work on the "setting" for your quilt and you can pull supplies from your stash for this once you see how your star(s) are coming together. If you'd like to do the large quilt and the checkerboard sashing, bring along a pile of 2" squares and I'll teach you to generate 4-patches as you make the star(s).
