This project could be used as a decorative wall hanging or a warm useful winter cover-up. Using a “Bali Pop” collection will make this project one step quicker or you can use fabric from your stash. A ‘Rob Peter to Pay Paul’ technique is used to create this modern leaf motif in gorgeous color ways. You will choose one of several forms of appliqué techniques to use on your project.

Supply list:

One pack of Hoffman ‘Bali Pops’ OR

Approx. 50 fabrics, 1/8 yd – (more if you love it) cut into 2 ½” strips

White or cream fabric 3/8 yd. – cut into 2 ½” strips

Dark (brown, navy, black, grey) fabric 1/3 yd. – cut into 2 ½” strips

1st border – ½ yd

2nd border and binding 1 ¾ yd.

Sewing machine (in good working order) cleaned, oiled and new needle.

(don’t forget foot pedal and power cord)

Rotary cutting equipment, (with 18 x 24 mat)

Thread to blend with fabrics

Templar plastic sheet (heat resistant)

Basic sewing supplies

Travel iron (if you have one)

Extension cord, in case you might need it.
