Where is maple syrup made in Ohio?

Maple syrup is produced primarily in Northeast Ohio where sugar maples thrive due to the elevation, temperature and soils. Maple sugar was discovered by Native Americans, who showed the early colonists how to tap the trees and boil the sap to sugar. Settlers from New England brought their skills in sugaring to Northeast Ohio, which became the center of Ohio's maple production and maple technology innovation. Today Lake Metroparks' maple syrup helps sustain Ohio's rank as seventh in the nation in maple production.
