**Cake Stand Quilt Class**

A pattern that can be worked up in any combination of fabrics will be put together in the two days of class. The blocks are set on point and use side and corner setting triangles with complementary borders. You are urged to try using button tufting as a finishing technique on this old time pattern. Pick your favorite color and add a light background to put this pattern to test. Combinations of red and white or blue and white are the traditionally most popular and usually sell for the most money. Holiday fabrics work beautifully in this project as well.

All of the basic cutting will be done prior to class.  
Basic rotary cutting skills required.

**Supplies needed to bring to class:**

- Machine required in good working order, cleaned, oiled and start with a new needle.
- Thread of the same brand and weight in the upper and lower positions. Different colors ok.
- Rotary cutting equipment-mat, plexi ruler, rotary cutter blade.
- Extension cord.
- Basic sewing supplies.
- Bring travel iron if available (irons and boards provided for in class)
- Approximately 85 buttons

**Yardage:** (using 42" wide fabrics)

- ½ yard of assorted background light prints (total)
- ¼ yard prints for blocks (assorted total yardage)
- ¼ yard inner border
- ½ yard outer border
- 1 yard for backing
- ½ yard for bias binding
- 1 yard batting
