## WOVEN FIELDS AND COIN FLOWERS PLAYSHOP

1-day workshop, Advanced Beginner & up

Here is a workshop for those adventurous quilters who have scraps burning on their shelves. A fun fusible art project that utilizes fabric strips woven for a background instead of piecing and fusible appliqué to enhance the design! Add some embellishments and you have an original art quilt. Bet you can't make just one!

### SUPPLIES:

- Fabric foundation about 15" square - if you want to work larger that's okay (I've used scrap fabric and/or fusible interfacing)
- Scrap strips at least 13" long for woven background (although you can do the weaving with shorter strips and "hide" short ends)
  - Amount of strips: 2 each of assorted strips or enough to cover your background square TWICE. (call instructor if this does not make sense)
  - Color suggestions: I've found the same value in similar colors is working well for me.
- Some circles or squares of contrasting color to use for flowers
- Some fusible web, about 3/4 yard
- Embellishments as desired (beads, embroidery thread, bias tape, rick-rack, etc.)
- Shears and/or other cutting tools
- Matching threads for sewing
- Sewing machine and accessories for it
- Optional: masking tape
- Then some batting (unless you're using fusible batting as a design surface)
- 15-inch square back fabric for backing of quilt
- 15-inch square batting

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
