The OC at the ELC is a new environmental nature club for families with children 10 years and older and groups of two or more. Through technology and outdoor activities we will observe the seasons at the Environmental Learning Center to feel more connected to our Lake County habitat. Weather and observational data will be collected to study the patterns of nature.

The OC at the ELC will meet monthly in 2011. Participants are encouraged to attend all 12 **FREE** programs as part of the seasonal data collection, but it is not required. Groups may join at any time. The club will meet every fourth Sunday from 1 to 4 pm at the Lake Metroparks Environmental Learning Center. Each month will have a theme relative to the season. Lake Metroparks staff specializing in a variety of areas will lead the programs.
