It has toys, books and snacks for sale.



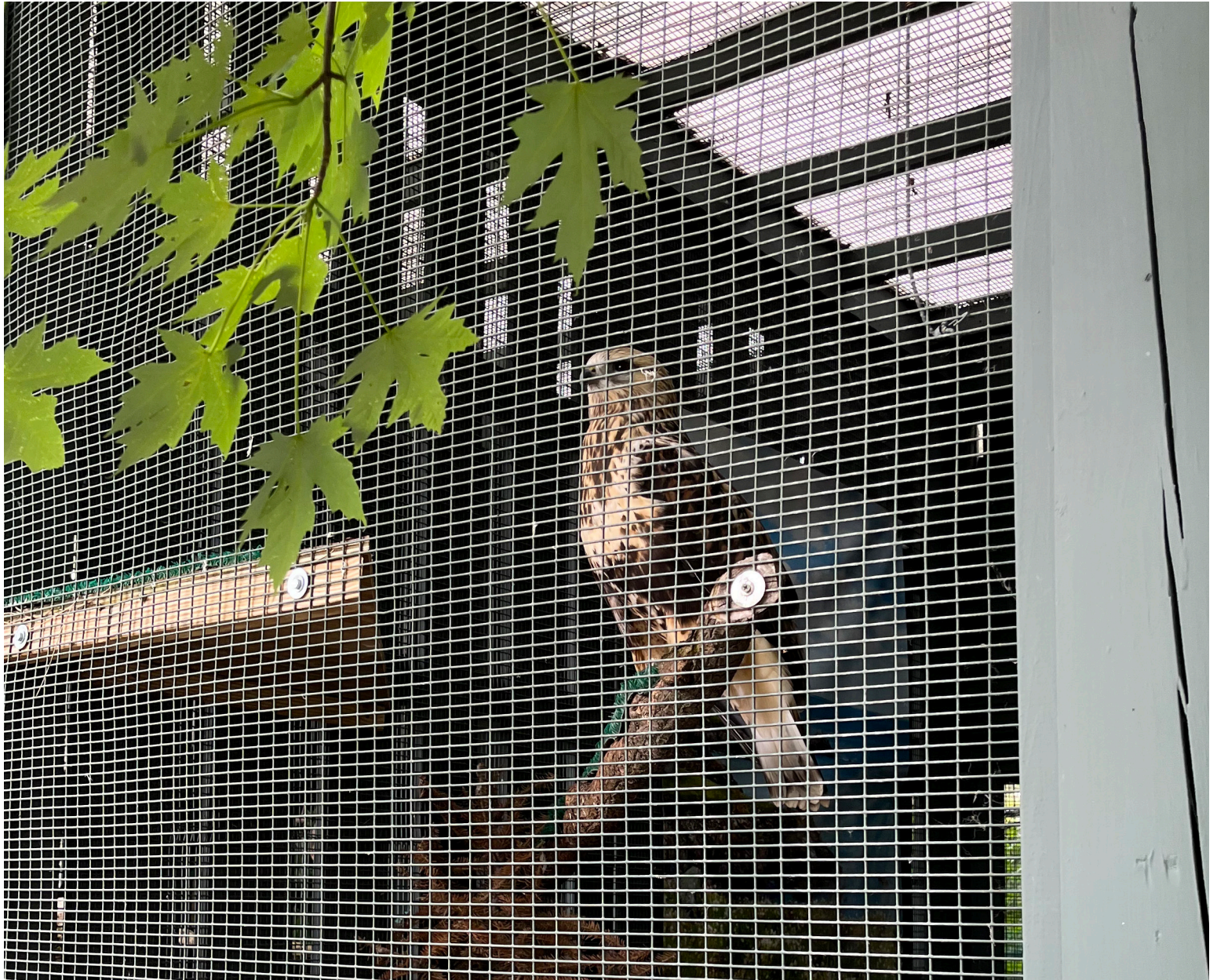
I can **relax** and **enjoy** the **sounds**
