#### 7. Resolution 2025-019, Levy, Auditor Certification

Mr. Palagyi explained Resolution 2025-019, Levy, Auditor Certification. Mr. Palagyi said that to be on the ballot this fall, we first need to ask the Auditor to certify how much the renewal of our 1.9 mill levy would generate and what the impact would be for every \$100,000 worth of property. He said we would expect the Auditor to provide us with those numbers in the next couple of weeks and then we would insert those numbers into a resolution requesting that the Board of Elections include our question on the Fall ballot.

Motion by Mr. Redmond to approve Resolution 2025-019, Levy, Auditor Certification. Seconded by Mr. Polivka. Motion passed unanimously.

#### VIII. Executive Director's Report

Mr. Palagyi said we are prepping the parks for summer between the rain events and all is going well. He said that with the wet spring, visitation across the parks was lower than usual, special events were a little smaller and rounds of golf played at our golf courses were down.

Mr. Palagyi said summer camps are full with 1,100 registered. He said shelters are very popular as usual with most weekends at popular shelters long gone. Mr. Palagyi said campsites are more than half filled and more than 75 percent of weekends full.

Mr. Palagyi said Farmpark will host the 2025 installment of HorseFest this coming weekend. The two-day event draws an average attendance of about 3,000 guests over two days.

Mr. Palagyi said that new AEDs have been placed throughout the parks at 26 locations.

#### IX. Executive Session

Mr. Palagyi said there is not a need for an Executive Session.
