1. Announcements

Overview of project concepts

Review of area through aerial drone footage.

Timeline: Begin early 2023, construction 2024

2. Discussion

1. Material Samples: Has there been any Geotech investigation for core logs required?
 - a. Not required – Some Geotech available for Phase I of trail and report will be provided to awarded contractor
 - b. Awarded consultant will determine if further Geotech investigation is necessary.
2. Any interest in nature-based shoreline alternative?
 - a. Not particularly interested in nature-based options because of feasibility, looking for the certainty of armored shoreline. Would review options, but would need concrete examples of situations where implemented.
3. Would contractor need to pursue easements where property tie-in is located?
 - a. LMP will handle any easement work needed. Current revetment wall does slightly overlap property line.
 - b. Master planning on adjacent property is underway, and they are amenable to possible construction access on property.
4. Scope Price Negotiable?
 - a. After selection of most qualified firm, LMP will negotiate price for scope of work.
5. Option for public access on site?
 - a. In the design phase, LMP would be interested in a cursory look at what that might look like.
6. Re: the bench for trail – How wide, elevation?

- a. The general location is identified on map, close to the elevation of where Phase I ends.
 - b. Bike path needs to meet ODOT standards for design because of funding source.
 - c. The path is 10' asphalt with 2' wide shoulders for Phase I (including overlooks).
7. Will there be overlooks in Phase II?
 - a. Most likely no, Design must be conscious of amount of cut behind path.
 - b. Retaining wall necessity will be determined based on design work.
8. When will selected firm be announced?
 - a. Once a contract is in place with selected firm.
9. Limit to number of pages on proposal?
 - a. No
10. Landscape design?
 - a. Not needed at this point.
11. Certain number of example projects required?
 - a. No. Most relevant projects as possible desired.
